Zealana Kiwi Fingering Mōrena Bag 023.0219

MATERIALS:

- Zealana Kiwi Fingering (40% Merino, 30% Brushtail Possum Fibre 30% Organic Cotton; 124m 40grams)
- 2 balls of shade 15 Aurora Pink
- 3mm Knitting Needles
- Darning needle

GAUGE: 27sts = 10cm TAKE TIME TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS

Bag (make 2)

Cast on 40 sts with 3mm Knitting Needles.

Rib Rows: *knit 2, Purl 2* repeat from * to * to the end

Repeat this rib row 5 more times (6 rows in total)

Stocking Stitch

Row 1: Knit Row 2: Purl

Continue to work in stocking stitch until work measures 10 cm from the beginning of the stocking stitch

Cast Off

Strap

Cast on 16 sts with 3mm Knitting Needles.

Row 1: Knit

Row 2: Purl

Row 3: Knit

Row 4: Purl

Row 5: Purl

Row 6: Knit

Row 7: Purl

Row 8: Knit

Continue to work in this 8 row sequence until strap measures approx. 2 mts

Cast off

This measurement is done with the strap lying flat and relaxed

Make up

Fold the strap in half and place a marker at the centre on both edges

Also place a marker at the centre of the bottom edge of the bag pieces

Place the right side of each bag piece to the strap, with the centre markers together attached the bag to the strap

Tie the strap ends in a beautiful bow and enjoy
