Zealana Rimu DK Scarf 025.0242

MATERIALS:

- Zealana Rimu DK (60% Merino, 40% Brushtail Possum Fibre; 128m 50grams)
- 4 balls R31 Kowhai
- 4mm Knitting Needles
- Darning needle

GAUGE: 20-22sts = 10cm TAKE TIME TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

Finished Measurements:

Approx. 28cm x 128cm (or desired length)

PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS:

Using 4mm needles and thumb method cast on 65 sts

Row 1: *K1, p3tog, yrn, p3tog, rep from * to last sts k1.

Row 2: Purl

1st and 2nd rows set pattern.

Keeping continuity of pattern continue until scarf measures approx. 10cm

Next Row: K1, p3tog, yrn, p3tog, k1, p3tog, yrn, p3tog, knit to last 8 sts, p3tog, yrn, p3top, k1,

p3tog, yrn, p3tog, k1.

Next Row: Purl

Continue in the last 2 row pattern until the middle section of the scarf measures the desired length, pictured is 108cm.

Next Row 1: *K1, p3tog, yrn, p3tog, rep from * to last sts k1.

Next Row 2: Purl

Row 1 and Row 2 set pattern.

Keeping continuity of pattern continue until this section measures approx. 10cm

TO MAKE UP

Sew in ends

Cover with a damp cloth and leave to dry.





Knitting Abbreviations:

K = Knit
P = Purl
Sts = Stitches
P3tog = Purl 3sts together
Yrn = yarn over and around needle
P3tog, yrn, p3tog = p3tog leaving sts on left
hand needle, yrn, purl tog the same 3 sts
again and slip all 3 sts off left hand needle.
