Runa Socks

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

21" / 53 cm long and 8" / 20 cm around

MATERIALS

- Zealana Artisan Tui (70% Fine New Zealand Merino, 15% Cashmere, 15% Brushtail Possum; 121 yds / 111m per 100 grams)
- 2 balls #T05 Charcoal
- set of 4 or 5 US size 8 (5.0 mm) doublepointed needles
- set of 4 or 5 US size 9 (5.5 mm) doublepointed needles
 OR SIZE NEEDED TO OBTAIN GAUGE
- tapestry needle

GAUGF

16 sts and 20 rows to 4" / 10 cm over unstretched 3 x 1 Ribbing

TAKE TIME TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE

STITCH PATTERN

3 x 1 Ribbing

Round 1: *k3, p1, rep from* to end of rnd.

Round 2: knit all sts.

Rep these 2 rnds for pattern.

SOCKS (MAKE 2)

Using smaller dpns, CO 32 sts.

Divide sts evenly over needles and join to work in the round being careful not to twist.

Knit 4 rnds. Work in 3×1 Ribbing until piece meas 6'' / 15 cm from CO edge.

Heel opening: on foll rnd BO 16 sts, then cont in patt to end of rnd.

On next rnd, CO 16 sts using Backwards Loop method, then cont in patt to end of rnd.

Cont as est until piece meas 12" / 30 cm from CO edge.

Switch to larger dpns and continue until piece meas 20" / 51 cm from CO edge.

Knit 4 rnds, then BO all sts loosely.

FINISHING

Using smaller dpns, pu and k 32 sts around heel opening. Knit 2 rnds, then BO all sts. Weave in all ends and block gently.
