X-Small, (Small, Medium, Large, X-Large)  
Sample shown is Small

## FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

130 (36, 42, 48, 54)"/76 (91, 107, 122, 137)  
cm wide and 21 ½ (22, 22 ½, 23, 23 ½)"/55  
(56, 57, 58, 60) cm long

## MATERIALS

Zealana Heron Worsted (80% New Zealand Merino, 20% Brushtail Possum; 109yd/100m per 50grams)

- 7 (8, 8, 9, 10) balls #H07 Carnival (MC)
- 1 ball #H06 Coral (CC)
- US size 7 (4.5mm) 32" circular needle
- US size G-6 (4.5mm) crochet hook
- 6 ½" buttons (buttons shown provided by Moving Mud)
- Stitch holder or scrap yarn
- US size 7 (4.5mm) or smaller spare needle
- Tapestry needle

## GAUGE

16 sts and 24 rows to 4"/10cm in Open Flame Stitch, measured in St st.

TAKE TIME TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE

## OPEN FLAME STITCH

(multiple of 14 + 3)

NOTE: Stitch count varies from row to row. Original count is restored on Rows 12 and 24.

Set-up Row (work once): K1, \*p1, yo, p1,



yo, k1, yo, p1, yo, p1, k2, k2tog, k3; rep from \*, end p1, yo, p1, sl 1 pwise wyib.

**Row 1 (RS):** K1, \*p1, k1, p1, yo, k1, yo, p1, k1, p1, k2, k2tog, k3; rep from \*, end p1, k1, p1, sl 1 pwise wyib.

**Row 2:** P1, \*k1, p1, k1, p6, k1, p1, k1, p3; rep from \*, end k2, sl 1 pwise wyif.

**Row 3:** K1, \*p1, k1, p1, k1, (yo, k1) twice, p1, k1, p1, k2, k2tog, k2, rep from \*, end p1, k1, p1, sl 1 pwise wyib.

**Row 4:** P1, \*(k1, p1, k1, p5) twice; rep from \*, end k1, p1, k1, sl 1 pwise wyif.

**Row 5:** K1, \*p1, k1, p1, k2, yo, k1, yo, k2, p1, k1, p1, k2, k2tog, k1; rep from \*, end k1, p1, k1, sl 1 pwise wyib.

**Row 6:** P1, \*k1, p1, k1, p4, k1, p1, k1, p7; rep from \*, end k1, p1, k1, sl 1 pwise wyif.

**Row 7:** K1, \*p1, k1, p1, k3, yo, k1, yo, k3, p1, k1, p1, k2, k2tog; rep from \*, end p1, k1, p1, sl 1 pwise wyib.

**Row 8:** P1, \*k1, p1, k1, p3, k1, p1, k1, p9; rep

from \*, end k1, p1, k1, sl 1 pwise wyif.

**Row 9:** K1, \*p1, k1, p1, k2, k2tog, k5, p1, k1, p1, k1, k2tog; rep from \*, end p1, k1, p1, sl 1 pwise wyib.

**Row 10:** P1, \*k1, p1, k1, p2, k1, p1, k1, p8; rep from \*, end k1, p1, k1, sl 1 pwise wyif.

**Row 11:** K1, \*p1, k1, p1, k2, k2tog, k4, p1, k1, p1, k2tog; rep from \*, end p1, k1, p1, sl 1 pwise wyib.

**Row 12:** P1, \*k1, p1, k1, p1, k1, p1, k1, p7; rep from \* end k1, p1, k1, sl 1 pwise wyif.

**Row 13:** K1, \*p1, k1, p1, k2, k2tog, k3, p1, k1, p1, yo, k1, yo; rep from \* p1, k1, p1, sl 1 pwise wyib.

**Row 14:** P1, \*k1, p1, k1, p3, k1, p1, k1, p6; rep from \*, end k1, p1, k1, sl 1 pwise wyif.

**Row 15:** K1, \*p1, k1, p1, k2, k2tog, k2, p1, k1, p1, (k1, yo) twice, k1; rep from \*, end p1, k1, p1, sl 1 pwise wyib.

**Row 16:** P1, \*(k1, p1, k1, p5) twice; rep from \*, end k1, p1, k1, sl 1 pwise wyif.

**Row 17:** K1, \*p1, k1, p1, k2, k2tog, k1, p1, k1,



p1, k2, yo, k1, yo, k2; rep from \*, end p1, k1, p1, sl 1 pwise wyib.

**Row 18:** P1, \*k1, p1, k1, p7, k1, p1, k1, p4; rep from \*, end k1, p1, k1, sl 1 pwise wyif.

**Row 19:** K1, \*p1, k1, p1, k2, k2tog, p1, k1, p1, k3, yo, k1, yo, k3; rep from \*, end p1, k1, p1, sl 1 pwise wyib.

**Row 20:** P1, \*k1, p1, k1, p9, k1, p1, k1, p3; rep from \*, end k1, p1, k1, sl 1 pwise wyif.

**Row 21:** K1, \*p1, k1, p1, k1, k2tog, p1, k1, p1, k2, k2tog, k4; rep from \*, end p1, k1, p1, sl 1 pwise wyib.

**Row 22:** P1, \*k1, p1, k1, p8, k1, p1, k1, p2; rep from \*, end k1, p1, k1, sl 1 pwise wyif.

**Row 23:** K1, \*p1, k1, p1, k2tog, p1, k1, p1, k2, k2tog, k4; rep from \*, end p1, k1, p1, sl 1 pwise wyib.

**Row 24:** P1, \*k1, p1, k1, p7, k1, p1, k1, p1; rep from \*, end k1, p1, k1, sl 1 pwise wyif.

#### FRONT

Cast on 52 (64, 76, 88, 100) sts and knit 4 rows. Begin working in Open Flame Stitch, working Set-Up Row 1. 61 (75, 89, 103, 117) sts. Work Rows 2-24 once, then Rows 1-24 until piece meas approx 18 ½ (19, 18 ½, 19, 18 ½)"/47 (48, 47, 48, 47) cm from CO edge, ending with a WS row. On foll RS row, drop the single knit st btw each pair of purl sts and allow to ladder down to CO edge; using the backwards loop method, CO 1 st over the newly formed ladder and cont in patt. 61 (75, 89, 103, 117). Knit all sts on all foll rows.

Work in Garter St for 1 (1 ½, 2, 2.5, 2.5)"/2 ½ (4, 5, 6, 6) cm ending with a WS row. On foll RS row, k15 (19, 22, 26, 29) sts, BO 31 (37, 45, 51, 59) sts, work to end. Working back and forth on k15 (19, 22, 26, 29) Right Shoulder sts, knit to last 4 sts, k2tog, k2. Knit one row. Rep these 2 rows 4x, then place rem sts on holder or scrap yarn. Break yarn. With WS facing, attach yarn and work

across Left Shoulder sts as follows: k2, ssk, work to end. Knit next row. Rep these 2 rows 4x, then place rem sts on holder or scrap yarn.

#### BACK

Work same as Front.

#### FINISHING

With WS facing, remount held Front and Back Right Shoulder sts on needles with open needle points facing the same way (sts may need repositioning). Using spare needle, 3-Needle BO all sts. Repeat for Left Shoulder.

Weave in all ends and block to open up lace pattern and ladders. With CC and crochet hook, make a slip knot. With CC held at back of work, beg at bottom edge and chain stitch on RS, trapping two ladder bars with each st. Work loosely to avoid creating puckering. When all ladder bars are worked, cut yarn and draw through final loop. Tighten gently and weave in end. Repeat as shown, or in desired configuration. ♦
