



## PATTERN

## Kiri Hat

Designed by Cirilia Rose

## FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

17" / 43 cm and 9" / 23 cm tall after blocking (note: hat will have a good deal of stretch)

## MATERIALS

- Zealana Artisan COZI (58% Merino, 22% Nylon, 15% Brushtail Possum Down, 5% Baby Alpaca; 186yds / 170m per 50 grams)
- 1 ball CO6 Peppermint
- 16" US size 3 (3.25 mm) circular needle
- 16" US size 4 (3.5 mm) circular needle
- set of 4 or 5 US size 4 (3.5 mm) double-pointed needles
- OR SIZE NEEDED TO OBTAIN GAUGE
- stitch marker
- tapestry needle
- black fabric paint or nail polish

## GAUGE

24 sts and 32 rows to 4" / 10 cm over unstretched Off-Set Ribbing on larger needles

TAKE TIME TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE

## PATTERN STITCH

Off-Set Ribbing (multiple of 2)

Rounds 1-7: \*k1, p1, rep from \* to end of rnd.

Rounds 8-14: \*p1, k1, rep from \* to end of rnd.

Repeat these 2 rounds for pattern.

## HAT

Using smaller circular needle, CO 104. Join to work in the rnd, being careful not to twist. Pm and work 2 repeats in Off-Set Ribbing. Switch to larger needles and work until piece meas 4 ½" / 11 cm from CO edge. Knit every rnd until piece meas 5 ½" / 14 cm from CO edge.



Decrease as foll every 3rd rnd (k2 rnds, dec on 3rd rnd):

**Dec Rnd 1:** \*k2tog, k11, rep from \* to end of rnd. 96 sts.

**Dec Rnd 2:** \*k2tog, k10, rep from \* to end of rnd. 88 sts.

**Dec Rnd 3:** \*k2tog, k9, rep from \* to end of rnd. 80 sts.

**Dec Rnd 4:** \*k2tog, k8, rep from \* to end of rnd. 72 sts.

**Dec Rnd 5:** \*k2tog, k7, rep from \* to end of rnd. 64 sts.

**Dec Rnd 6:** \*k2tog, k6, rep from \* to end of rnd. 56 sts.

Work 2 rnds, then decrease as foll every other rnd:

**Dec Rnd 1:** \*k2tog, k5, rep from \* to end of rnd. 56 sts.

**Dec Rnd 2:** \*k2tog, k4, rep from \* to end of rnd. 48 sts.

**Dec Rnd 3:** \*k2tog, k3, rep from \* to end of rnd. 40 sts.

**Dec Rnd 4:** \*k2tog, k2, rep from \* to end of rnd. 32 sts.

**Dec Rnd 5:** \*k2tog, k1, rep from \* to end of rnd. 24 sts.

**Dec Rnd 6:** \*k2tog, rep from \* to end of rnd. 16 sts.

Cut yarn, leaving a 12" / 30 cm tail. Using tapestry needle, thread yarn through rem sts and pull gently to close hole.

## FINISHING

Weave in all ends and steam or wet block if desired. Using rem yarn, make pom-pom. Optional: dip ends of pom-pom in black fabric paint or nail polish and allow to dry.
