




DOUBLE KNIT PATTERN

STITCH KEY

- R07 Shadow (MC)
- R01 Natural (CC)

NOTE: Each square on chart represents TWO stitches, a knit stitch on the side of the fabric facing you and a purl stitch on the side away from you. Be sure to bring both yarns to the back or to the front as you knit and purl. Knit the first stitch of the pair with the color shown in the chart and purl the second stitch with the color not shown in the chart.

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

9" / 23 cm tall and 23.5" / 60 cm around

MATERIALS

- Zealana Performa Rimu DK (60% Fine New Zealand Merino, 40% Brushtail Possum; 140 yds / 128 m per 50 grams)
- 1 ball R01 Natural (CC); 2 balls R07 Shadow (MC)
- 20" / 50 cm size 5 (3.75 mm) circular needle
- OR SIZE NEEDED TO OBTAIN GAUGE
- tapestry needle

GAUGE

36 sts and 30 rows to 4" / 10 cm in Double Knitting

TAKE TIME TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE

PATTERN

With MC, CO 105. Join to knit in the round, being careful not to twist.

Rnd 1: Purl.

Rnd 2: Knit.

Rep Rnds 1 and 2 twice. On foll rnd, inc as foll: *k1, m1R, rep from * to end of rnd. 210 sts.

Begin Double Knitting Chart, working Rnds 1-16 3x, then Rnds 1-8 1x.

On foll rnd, dec as foll: with MC, *k2tog, rep from * to end of rnd. 105 sts.

Rnd 1: Purl.

Rnd 2: Knit.

Rep Rnds 1 and 2 twice, then loosely BO all sts in pattern

FINISHING

Weave in all ends and block gently.
