



PATTERN

Marama Sleeve

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

3.25" / 8 cm tall and 6.5" / 17 cm around

MATERIALS

- Zealana Luxuria Air Marle (40% Cashmere, 40% Brushtail Possum, 20% Mulberry Silk; 127 yds / 116 m per 50 grams) NOTE: 1 ball will make 3 sleeves.
- 1 ball A448 Seafoam
- US size 4 (3.5) needles
- OR SIZE NEEDED TO OBTAIN GAUGE
- 2 yards leather lacing
- tapestry needle
- crochet hook

GAUGE

22 sts and 24 rows to 4" / 10 cm in Garter Stitch

TAKE TIME TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE

SLEEVE

CO 20 sts. Work in Garter Stitch, slipping last st of every row pwise wyif until piece meas 3.25" / 8 cm from CO edge. Work Short Row as foll: k5, turn work, k to end. Resume working in Garter Stitch until piece meas 6.5" / 17" from CO edge. BO all sts.

FINISHING

With leather lacing threaded on tapestry needle, carefully whipstitch CO edge to BO edge. Weave in all ends on WS. Affix single fringe tassel accent to lower edge as foll: cut two 6" pieces of leather lacing and fold in half. Using crochet hook and working from WS, pull looped laces through to WS. Thread cut edges of lacing through looped end and pull gently to tighten. Trim tassel ends if desired.
